

# Primary BASKETBALL RULES

# Primary Rules - 2023 Friday Afternoons 4.00, 4.40 and 5.20 time slots Venues - Prince Alfred College / St Ignatius Primary (Norwood)

- All grades are to use a size 5 ball.
- □ □ Height of rings to be 10 feet for Grade 5, 6, 7.
- B'6' rings are only to be used if schools do not have 10 foot rings
- I5 minute Halves / 2 minutes Half Time
- Games played over a 40 Minute Time Slot

#### **Competition Rules**

- Four team fouls per quarter apply before bonus fouls shots are applied.
- For all grades the three-point rule shall apply.
- **NO TIME OUTS** permitted during the match
- A tech foul should be imposed for any audible obscenity.
- <sup>□</sup> The Association operates under FIBA rules.
- D Players on all indoor courts must wear non-marking footwear
- It is recommended that if a player wears a T shirt under his/her team single at any indoor venue that it be the same colour as the team singlet.
- <sup>□</sup> It is recommended that regulation shorts are to be worn.
- Each team is to supply a scorer.
  The home team is to supply a timekeeper (Team listed first)
- School basketball uniforms must be worn, with numbers as per basketball rules.

#### **Reported Players -**

- If a player is sent from the court by the umpire for a reportable offence, the umpire <u>MUST</u> at the conclusion of the game complete a report card provided by the coach.
- Any player Reported in a game the information will be forwarded to the player's Sports Co-ordinator or Principal for appropriate action.

Note: This does not include normal fouling off.

## Year 5/6 Friday Competition Basketball Rules 2023

#### 1) Games consist of two 15-minute halves

- a. Game timer starts at scheduled time (4:00pm. 4:40pm, 5:20pm)
- b. Each team must provide a scorer or timekeeper to assist each week
- c. Scoresheets for each game will be provided by the Host school.
- d. Maximum 2-minute half time break
- e. Clock does not stop for timeouts, unless in last 2-minutes of game

#### 2) Scoring rules

- a. 3 point shot rule does not apply
  - i. This rule encourages players to move closer to the basket to score
- b. 16 points max. per player
  - i. This rule encourages players to share the ball more equitably

#### 3) Mercy rule

a. In the event that a team is **10 points ahead**, they must retreat to their half when the opposing team gains possession

#### 4) Jump Balls

a. Jump balls will apply at beginning of each half and during games (no possession arrow)

#### 5) No Zone policy

- a. Players are to play man-on-man where possible (umpires' discretion on call)
  - i. This rule is to allow ample space for both the defence and offence to manoeuvre within the full length and width of the court

### 6) Umpiring

- a. Umpires are encouraged to assist with the running of the game, explain rules where necessary and de-escalate any heated situations
  - i. Cross-court (backcourt) rule applies
  - ii. 3-seconds in key applied at umpires' discretion if no advantage is gained
  - iii. Tech foul immediately called for swearing or umpire dissent
  - iv. Unsportsmanlike foul immediately called for unnecessary rough play
